BLAZES TO HISTORIC NATIONAL RECORD



Reliance Foundation athlete Gurindervir Singh delivered a historic performance at the Senior National Federation Cup in Ranchi, rewriting the national record books in the men's 100m. After clocking 10.17s in the semifinals, Gurindervir returned even stronger in the final, storming to a sensational 10.09s to set a new national record and establish himself as India's fastest man.

The remarkable achievement highlighted Gurindervir's consistency, composure, and rapid rise on the national stage, marking a significant milestone for Indian sprinting and Reliance Foundation's high-performance athletics programme.

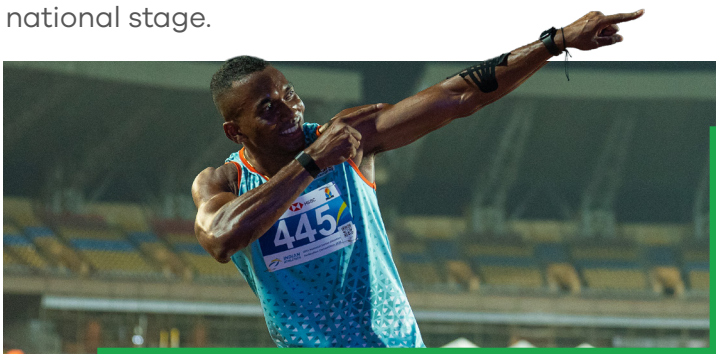
